## Steps Suppliers Need to Take to Remain in Compliance

**IDENTIFY**: GSI Registration and Item & Location Identification

- Register with a <u>GSI Member Organization</u> to obtain a company prefix and assign GTINs to your items and GLNs to your ship-from, sold-from, and manufacture-from locations.
- Fill out the GHSC-PSM GTIN and GLN Submission Form and send it to datasync@ghsc-psm.org

**CAPTURE**: Pack Labeling - For more information, visit Overview of Labeling and Barcode Requirements

- Internally prepare your company barcoding for your product. Gather necessary department leads (Marketing, Supply Chain, Procurement, Logistics, Distribution).
- Label the Secondary & Tertiary pack trade item packaging level (i.e., Carton or Case) with a GSI-128 Barcode or GSI DataMatrix, with the following data encoded:
  - (01) Global Trade Item Number (GTIN); (10) Batch/Lot Number; (17) Expiration Date; (21)
    Serial Number (Serial Number Only Required for Pharmaceuticals)
- Label the Logistic Unit packaging level (i.e., Pallet) with a GSI-128 Barcode, with the following data encoded: (00) Serial Shipping Container Code (SSCC)

SHARE: Master Data Sync via the GSI Global Data Synchronization Network (GDSN)

- Join one of the GDSN-certified data pools.
- Assign an internal GDSN lead within your organization.
  - Create a strategy to centralize and send product content.
  - Start with a few key items to be sent to GHSC-PSM, conduct pilots, and scale to send more items upon receiving feedback.
  - Synchronizing Data The process and methods used in achieving the goal of data synchronization.
    - Step 1: If your organization is not currently registered in the GDSN, identify, and sign up with a GDSN certified data pool of your choice.
    - Step 2: Load trade item attribute information in preparation for publication.
    - Step 3: Inform the GHSC-PSM Data Synchronization Team (datasync@ghsc-psm.org) when your organization is ready for initial publication.
    - Step 4: Publish items to GHSC-PSM's GLN 0858939007009.
    - Step 5: Manage Catalog Item Confirmation (CIC) Responses from GHSC-PSM.
    - Step 6: Perform ongoing item maintenance through your GDSN-certified data pool. Any time a change is made to the item information, an update should be made and communicated through the GDSN.
